Tracking participants over several years can be difficult and costly. Even after making special efforts to locate people who have moved, each year a few more people from the original sample may not be reached or may refuse to cooperate. In the Eisenhower evaluation, 50 percent of the initial sample (60 percent of teachers remaining in the schools) responded to all three surveys. When a sample is tracked for several years, the cumulative loss of respondents may eventually yield such a small proportion of the original sample as not to accurately represent that original sample. Moreover, the proportion affected tends to diminish at each step of the program logic model, which can reduce the size of the expected effect on long-term outcomes so small as to be undetectable. That is, if the program reached half the targeted audience, changed attitudes among half of those it reached, half of those people changed their behavior, and half of...
